This week, our K-8 students joined with Walgett Community College students in Language Song Collaboration workshops supported by Kelsie Strasek-Barker, Luke Hyatt and Ros McGregor. Students learnt to sing in language the Flag Song and Going Home Now. The songs were recorded at Walgett Community College High School. Students sang the songs at their own NAIDOC Assembly this week.

Over the last few weeks we have been trialing changes to the secondary break times. As of Tuesday 24th July 2018, secondary students commence classes at 8.50am and work through without a break until 11.30am. Lunch for secondary students is now 40 minutes. Secondary students with a lunch pass are able to sign out at 11.30am. The lunch pass allows students to go home, have lunch and return on or before 12.05pm. If students need to go down the street they are to conduct their business and return to school. Lessons recommence at 12.10pm.

At present we are providing, at no cost to students, hot green lunches on Monday and Wednesday. On Tuesday, Thursday and Friday the expectation is that students either bring their lunch to school or buy their lunch and recess from the canteen. There will be no green lunches on Tuesday, Thursday or Friday. Parents and carers can pay in advance at the office.

The students are able to access our breakfast program in the morning at no cost to them. This program continues to be well-supported by our students.

Parents and carers can purchase uniforms from the front office. The uniforms are at cost and the school does not make any money out of the sales. Parents and carers can pay off the uniform purchase by paying a deposit when taking uniforms and paying the rest in instalments.

A reminder to all, if you behave or act inappropriately, while on or in the immediate vicinity of the Collarenebri Central School sites, it may result in my issuing a directive in accordance with my powers under the Inclosed Lands Protection Act 1901 to prohibit or otherwise restrict your entry to the Collarenebri Central School sites.

Our athletics carnival was held today as part of our NAIDOC celebrations. This is a good lead up to the NBSA K-12 Athletics carnival at Lightning Ridge on Friday 27th July 2018 and the Barwon Athletics at Collarenebri the following week.

Finally, thank you for supporting our students and staff throughout the term. Students return to school on Tuesday 24th July 2018.

I would like to say how proud myself and all the staff at CCS are of these students completing work placement. There will be another round of placements in Term 3 (6th – 10th August).

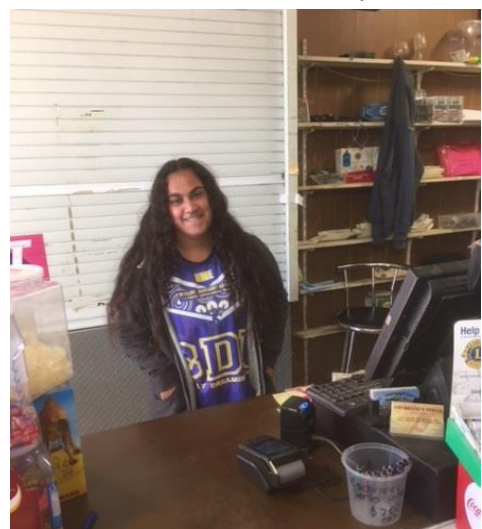
